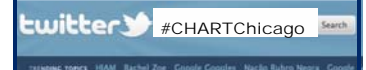

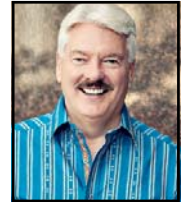

Regional Training Forum - Orlando

In May, the Orlando RTF had a double header and hit 2 home runs with their presenters. **Jessie Bray**, VP of Training for Romacorp. Inc, presented a very engaging presentation on ***Building a Culture of Accountability***. This seminar, built in partnership with Edge Training®, showed us the unpacked opportunities we have in holding people accountable at all levels in our organizations and for us personally and professionally.

In addition, **Monique Donahue**, VP, Research & Development for American Hotel & Lodging Educational Institute, gave us a sneak preview of a key portion of CHART's newest competency workshop, ***Process Improvement***. As trainers, our goal is to teach new skills and change or improve employee performance. But how do we know if we've been successful in doing this? This session explored the Kirkpatrick Model of measuring the effectiveness of training programs and included examples and tips for overcoming measurement challenges.
