Opening keynote speaker, **Tanner Corbridge**, Area Vice President and Executive Facilitator of Partners in Leadership, will guide us along a step-by-step plan to create significant cultural transition within our organizations. Inspired by the story of the Wizard of Oz, and based on principals from the best selling book, *Journey to the Emerald City*, Tanner introduces the classic model that hospitality organizations throughout



the world have used to create a culture of greater employee ownership and engagement.

While observing, "Either you manage the culture or the culture will manage you," Tanner provides a process of accelerating a transition to a Culture of Accountability, a culture where people at every level of the organization think and act in the manner necessary to achieve Key Organizational Results. The strategic process he will illustrate has enabled organizations to define and create specific shifts in the way their people go about achieving results. His dynamic presentation style is very engaging and will be a great kick-off to our conference.

As the authors of *Journey to the Emerald City* state, "To . . . achieve their goals and accomplish their desired result, each of (the characters) has to think and act in ways that are different from those that are familiar and comfortable. It isn't until they start acting different that they reach their destination."

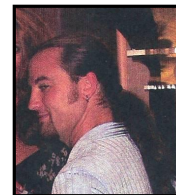

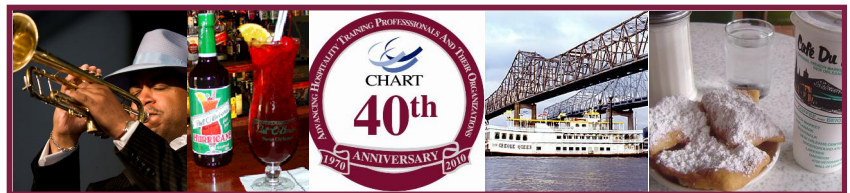

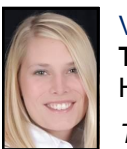
New Orleans Conference Team
